

Sunday, July 23, 2017 - "I-Will B: The One" - Norflette Shumake

Key Passages: Joshua 24, Exodus 17, Acts 4

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- · Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- We are all made with gifts and talents to serve God and to serve others
- Joshua 24: "As for me and my house we will serve the Lord"
 - · Joshua is saying I'm not going to "do me"
 - He i saying I am going to "do God"
- What we serve will either REDUCE us or ENLARGE us
 - In Egypt Pharaoh wanted them to serve to reduce and abuse tham
 - But God brought his people out of Egypt so they could serve him. And he would ENLARGE their influence and reach and area
 - God wants our service to enlarge us
- If you have an inability to serve/worship/sacrifice (which it what serving the Lord means), something is a "Pharaoh" in your life
 - · The enemy has you in some kind of bondage
 - Our service is just part of our worship
- God wants us to be like Him NOT like Pharaoh or whatever is keeping us from service and worship
 - We become like what we worship
 - He wants us living lives around the King and his mission
 - Our mission is not the church...but the mission of the church is the great commission (Matthew 28)
 - Living out the mission of the King with the character of the King
- In Acts 4 Peter and John heal someone and the pharisees say "these guys are 'idiots' but we can tell they have been with Jesus"
- Being with Jesus makes all the difference
- · Joshua learned the importance of spending time with God
 - What makes you effective is not your talent/ability but your time with God
 - Moses showed Joshua this
 - Joshua's time spent with God enlarged his vision on his spy trip to the promised land
 - Joshua lives on mission because he spent time with the one who gives mission
- "Once God has your heart, He has everything you have" Norflette Shumake
 - We are called to say to God that our lives don't belong to us, but it belongs to our father
 - The life of a believer is to say "God I want to do WHATEVER you want me to do."
- Equipped to serve outside of the church, inside of the church
 - Joshua was trained by Moses to be a leader of God's people
 - Sometimes serving in the church helps us be equipped for life "out there"

- 1. From a practical standpoint, how does Joshua's declaration, "as for me and my house we will serve the Lord." play out in your everyday life?
- 2. What are the things in your life that are preventing you from serving/worshipping/sacrificing to God?
- 3. How has God made your more like Him through serving Him?
- 4. How are you doing spending time with God lately? How is that affecting your mission positively or negatively?
- 5. What does it mean to you that your life does not belong to you but to God? How does that manifest itself in your own life?
- 6. How might God be calling you to serve in the church or outside of the church?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
