

Sunday, February 3, 2019 - "Rooted - Week 4 - Abide and Be Fruitful" - Doug Kempton

Key Passages: Jeremiah 17:7-8, John 15:1-17

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- What if Grace was "A church that does not cease to bear fruit" (fruit = the word of God lived out in our lives)
- John 15: Jesus is telling his disciples that things will change (after he is crucified) but also how to navigate and deal with hard things and circumstances
- Jesus says "I Am..." -> the 7th time in the book of John
 - The TRUE vine (Jesus IS the promised messiah and he was who he said he was)
 - If he is the true vine there must be a false one (things we connect to other than Him)
 - v2 & 6: You're either with me or against me, connected or rejected (salvation comes through Jesus alone)
- He prunes us so that we can bear more fruit
 - God refines us
 - This passage does not say we can lose our salvation
- It's an invitation to INTIMACY and fruitfulness with God
 - Abide = to reside or to live (living/residing with Jesus)
 - Whether we abide or not determines if we bear fruit
 - If we don't abide we risk intimacy NOT eternity
- 3 Markers for someone who abides
 - 1) God's word stays with you (v7)
 - Rehem = God's dyanmic, living word spoken to us
 - These words that God speaks or another follower of Jesus speaks STAY WITH US
 - 2) God's love surrounds you
 - Love that surpasses knowledge
 - Basking in the love of God -> opinion of others matters less and less
 - 3) You are obedient (v10)
 - If you keep my commandments
 - Get to NOT have to
- Parents/caretakers want this with their kids
- When kids (we) step out of line it doesn't mean they (we) aren't kids anymore, but it affects relationship
- When you abide the world will see
 - God made famous by the fruit in our lives
 - obedience = love God, love others -> everything else will work out
- v11: All of this so that we may be joyful and fruitful in every season

- 3. How have you experienced intimacy with God in the past? What was it like?

- 5. When was a time when God was made famous by the fruit in your life?
- 6. How is God calling you to abide with him today? What does it look like for you personally?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
