Key Passages: 2 Corinthians 3:7-18, 2 Corinthians 4:6-7, James 3:9

## Main Ideas

- 2 Corinthians 3:7-18
  - Moses met with God in the Old Testament and his face was radiant from being in God's presence...but the radiance would fade
  - We are transformed to be more and more like Jesus (it doesn't fade, it grows)
- 2 Corinthians 4:6-7
  - We are carriers of the greatest treasure know to man. We carry God's presence
  - We are called to reflect the glory of our father
  - Ever-increasing: not called to stay the same but to become more like Jesus
- What is glory? God's greatness, beauty, splendor, reflection. The sum total of all of his attributes. His absolute separateness and supremacy
- What is the soul? mind, emotions, will (head, heart, gut). Immaterial part of is in need of transformation so we can reflect the glory of God.
- We're all on a journey to expand the capacity of our souls
- Three ways that we can expand
  - 1) Learning PATIENCE
    - Our perception of time is different than God's (Moses on the mountain was long to the people, they rotund away quickly in God's perception)
    - · Learning to wait patiently does something in us
    - In the waiting, God exposes what is truly in our hearts
    - Whatever we are waiting for or desiring becomes subordinate to the desire for intimacy with God

  - 2) Giving HONOR
    - Honor = to regard someone with great respect (James 3:9)
    - We're all made in God's image -> we're called to honor ALL PEOPLE
    - "If you don't learn the heavenly principle of honor, you may forfeit your highest calling" Stacey Lemanski
  - 3) Growing in HUMILITY (humility = a right view of ourselves, not insecure and not prideful)
    - Pride = a foolish and irrationally corrupt sense of personal value, status or accomplishments
    - God OPPOSES the proud but gives GRACE to the humble (Grace is God's favor and power)
- Toos for transformation
  - Pay attention (where is the Spirit inviting you to be transformed?)
  - Practice the presence of God (breath prayer etc.)
  - Renew your mind (neuro-pathways: highways of negative thought/talk. Romans 12)

- 2. What does it mean to you that you are called to reflect the glory of God in an ever-increasing way?
- 3. How has god showed you to wait patiently for Him?

- 5. How is God asking you to grow in humility?
- 6. Of the tools for transformation, which one seems like the best for you to focus on right now? Why?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
