Key Passages: Psalm 67, Matthew 9:35-38

Main Ideas:

- God loves each person and each person is important to him
- The grace of Jesus is available to all of us
- God uses all sorts of people, God can use anyone
 - God uses us even though we are weak
 - God uses us sometimes in unusual ways
- We are called to be workers for the harvest of God’s kingdom
- George said “If we keep thinking and feeling without acting, soon we will be unable to act.”
- We can be men and women of prayer (like the woman at church that was a big part of George’s story)
- God’s passion is that everyone has an opportunity to hear the gospel
- We respond to God’s grace and a vision for the world with action
- We are called to both radical discipleship and radical grace
