Key Passages: Luke 20:19-47

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- · Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- Jesus is doing away with political/social hierarchy
 - Kingdom of God = everyone the same
 - All valued and welcomed at the table
- In this passage the religious leaders make 2 attempts to trap Jesus
 - He answers with the WHAT: what do we do. how do we live.
 - · He answers with the WHY: why we should do the "what"
- Paying a tribute to Caesar
 - No matter how Jesus answers -> he will be wrong (or so they think)
 - He will be hated by people (for saying the have to pay taxes) or by Rome (for saying they shouldn't pay taxes)
 - · Caesar Tiberius said he was the son of God
 - He was not good/moral/benevolent
 - Taxes + a horrible guy who claimed he was the son of God = really terrible for the jewish people
 - But jesus called the people and us to be obedient to and to honor our leaders even if the aren't honoring God (i.e. Tiberius)
 - · He also calls us to give to God what is Gods
 - Loving God
 - Loving our neighbor
- City of God vs. Earthy City
 - There are citizens of the city of God and citizens of an earthly city (one is good and holy and one is foul and selfish)
 - · We are to bring hope to those who are still in the earthly city
 - These things exist in the same space and the same time
- What does this have to do with taxes?
 - Romans 13:1, 1 Peter 2:17
 - Obligation to honor our leaders
 - Jeremiah 29:4,7 Seek the welfare of the city (even though the jewish people were exiles in Babylon)
- But, WHY?
 - Attempt #2 to trip up jesus is about marriage
 - Jesus is saying, it's not about marriage, it's about resurrection
 - All live to him
 - There are 2 cities BUT no dual citizenship Doug Kempton
 - Life to the full is in God (not just eternally, but also in the present) JOHN 10:10
 - We are transformed by Jesus, His Spirit, Resurrection
 - It's a process for the sake of others
 - Revival = restoration to life/concsiousness
- Resurrection brings life and life to the full through Jesus

- 5. Where do you need to see revival (restoration of life/consciousness) in your life/family/ministry?
- 6. How is God calling you to be hope to your neighbors who are not citizens of the "city of God" yet?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
