Key Passages: Ephesians 2:12-22, Galatians 3:27-29, Ephesians 3:8-11

Main Ideas

- Is unity necessary and WHY?
- The real questions is actually, :Are we united or are we not?"
- 4 Unity Truths
- 1) We ARE united
 - We are <u>actually</u> one
 - Peace w/ God through Jesus allows us to have peace with one another
 - Unity is not what we are working FOR it is what we are working FROM
 - v15-16 This is what HAS happened
 - We are A NEW RACE (Galatians 3:27-29)
 - "Clothed in Christ"
 - The outer garment
 - We are still different and unique and diverse BUT our identity in Christ covers over every other marker that we have. It becomes the priority for our identity
- 2) We sabotage unity when we hold any identity marker above Christ
 - Identity markers are not necessarily bad...but it's about the priority of our markers
 - God has made us diverse on purpose
 - We are made to move towards people that are different than us and make an impact on their lives
 - If we are hesitant or unwilling to move towards those that are different, then we need to examine our priorities
- 3) The Spirit of God moves through our unity
 - Unity is a multiplier)v22)
 - People will see when we come together in unity.
 - The building of the tabernacle or the wall in Nehemiah
- 4) Our unity makes God known
 - Ephesians 3:10-11
 - Unified church makes God known
 - We are one in our diversity. God designed us to be diverse and beautiful.
 - John 17:21
 - There is no limit to what God can do through the unified church
