Key Passages: 1 Peter 2:1-12

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- · Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

## Main Ideas

- 1 Peter is written to people living as outcasts and they were trying to answer a question that we are asking today; How can you and I be everyday saints in a world that is hostile towards us?
- Peter outlines the ethics (how they and we are called to live) if we want to make an impact for God
- We can't let ourselves off the hook too easily just because the words are intense
- Put away all malice: No Ill will towards anyone
  - Is there a person that when you think of them you cringe inside?
  - It may be hard to pray for God's blessing for them
  - This can be toward a person or a group of people
- Put away deceit and hypocrisy
  - Deceit = the same word for decoy in the greek, anytime you put on a false front
  - Hypocrisy -> When we are obsessed with the sins of others but not willing to work through our own sin
- Put away envy and slander
  - Jealous, hoping someone trips up a bit, their misfortune leads to our fortune
  - Slander = any time we use language to tear someone down or weaken their reputation
    - We do this out of self protection
    - · Are the words you are using building up or tearing down?
    - This can happen on social media too
- Abstain from passion of the flesh
  - Any time you know you're supposed to do something and you do something else
  - · Moving towards what you want instead of what God wants
- On our own we are incapable of doing any of this
- 2 Keys to living this out
  - 1) Priority
    - Jesus having the most important place in our live
    - "Jesus + nothing = everything"
    - v2 Long for pure spiritual milk
    - When we do this God reveals who he is and who we are
  - 2) Identity
    - All that we do is rooted in our identity
    - Who we believe we are in Christ -> conduct Peter was talking about
    - v9 You are:
      - Chosen by God
      - A Royal Priesthood (we are royalty
      - Loved beyond what we could ever comprehend
