

Saturday & Sunday, December 9 & 10, 2017 - "Micah 6:6-8 - Justice" - Doug Kempton

Key Passages: Micah 6:6-8, Isaiah 61:8, Isaiah 58:6-8, Amos 5:24

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- Satan wants to kill, steal, and destroy...all of us
- Impact 2018 is about taking ground back from Satan
- Isaiah 61:8 For I the Lord love justice...
 - Shouldn't we want to give the Lord what He loves
 - We bless the Lord by giving him what He loves: Justice
- Micah 6:6-8 (Micah is a peer of Isaiah, they prophesied to the same people)
 - Most of the book of Micah is in 2nd person plural (you all)
 - Chapter 6 moves to the 1st person singular (Micah is talking about himself)
- What is the way of true worship?
 - Micah talks about things he is supposed to do...they are good things
 - He then exaggerates and eventually asks the questions "What will actually please you God?"
 - Impact is a season of WORSHIP not just giving
 - God is after our heart
 - A bad gift given with a good heart is still a gift (Doug giving his mom a handmade peace pipe)
- · God tells Micah what He wants
 - 1) Walk humbly with God
 - Knowing who you are and who God is
 - Giving the gifts God has given us back to him
 - The more aware of God's Grace and Forgiveness the more you extend grace and forgiveness
 - 2) Love kindness
 - Covenant kindness (actively moving toward others)
 - Even when people don't earn it/act the way they should/live a lifestyle that we live
 - 3) Do justice (what does this mean?)
 - Anytime you see something unfair/cruel/oppressive you step in and bridge the gap
 - Courage Home rescuing girls from sex trafficking in India, SOAR flipping the statistics on literacy in the city of Detroit
 - Using our power or influence to affect injustice (GraceKids rice bowls -> 1900 meals for the hungry)
 - Amos 5:24
- It's not complicated...BUT it's also not easy (it will cost a great deal)
- It's like God is saying, "I've given you some stuff. What are you going to do with it?"
- We are called to ask the question: What do you want me to do/give/be to bring the Lord what he loves?

Questions (Feel free to use all of these, some of these, or none of these)

- 1. Do you think God is getting all of your heart right now? Why or why not?
- 2. Where is there somewhere in your life, job, relationships where you need to see God take back ground from the enemy?
- 3. How is God calling you to be a part of taking ground back from the enemy?
- 4. How are you doing at walking humbly with God? How do you need to grow?
- 5. How are you doing at loving kindness? Are you actively moving toward others?
- 6. When was a time when God used you to bring justice? How is God calling you to step into a more active role in doing justice?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or message?
