Key Passages: 1 Corinthians 15:20-23, 50-58, Revelation 21, Psalm 121

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- Hope Restored Series: Our desire is that we would all have a greater sense of hope and it would spill into every other area of our lives
- Hope is the catalyst for so many other good things in our lives
  - Living out the one word challenge starts with hope (some of us that is our word)
  - Hope leads to Joy (Romans 12:12), boldness (2 Corinthians 3:12), faith and love (Colossians 1:4-5), endurance and power (Isaiah 40), Anchors our soul (Hebrews 6:19)
  - If we lose hope, we lose motivation
- Heart Sickness (from last week Proverbs 13:12a)
- David was in a battle for hope in Psalm 42 & 43
  - He preaches to himself 3 times
  - His sermon to himself was, "Hope in God"
- We all talk to and preach to ourselves ("no one talks to you more than you")
  - We have a tendency to place our hopes in many other things besides God
  - John Calvin said, "Man's nature, so to speak, is a perpetual factory of idols."
- The only way out of heart sickness is to short our confidence and our hope to God
  - Psalm 121: We lift our eyers and see God more clearly
  - David was lifting his eyes in Psalm 42 & 43
- Hope & Wait are closely related
  - David looks back and sees that God has been faithful and looks forward to all God has promised
  - 360 Perspective = Looking back and seeing what God has done and looking forward to his promises
  - If we have an accurate understanding of what God is doing and what God will do --> source of HOPE
- Paul is writing about life and death and eternity in 1 Corinthians 15
  - We will all be changed
  - All those in Christ will get a new body (Just like Jesus' body) PHYSICALLY like him
  - Jesus' body was resurrected so our bodies will be resurrected
- Revelation 21: New heaven and New earth
  - Jesus returning to be with us..here...where we are
  - 360 perspective -> what is promised in scripture -> shape everything we do and look forward to..
  - Making all things new AND God is inviting us to participate in making all things new TODAY
  - Every act of love/kindness, service, justice, sacrifice for others ...every piece of art or new song will "find it's way into the new world" (NT WRIGHT)
- Sometimes hope comes from being a part of something bigger
  - Do not grow weary of doing good. "be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord"
  - God is using us to make all things new

- 3. What are some of the things that you have been tempted to place your hope in apart from God?

- 5. What is God calling you to as a part of Him making all things new?
- 6. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or message?
