Key Passages: John 8:31-47, Zephaniah 3:17, Romans 10:14

## Main Ideas

- John 8:31-47
  - Maybe Jesus' most intense conversation with the religious leaders
  - People are listening -> they decide to follow Jesus because of what they hear
- Commentary on effects of truth and lies
  - The effects on us as individuals but also on groups/families/society
  - LIES --> Bondage/Slavery TRUTH --> Freedom
  - We all have something we believe that isn't true
- Ripples of Truth
  - Central truth = Jesus is our freedom (Our life and our salvation)
  - Another truth: I am fearfully and wonderfully made
  - God has a plan of my life
  - All people are created equal
  - \*\*All Scripture is an opportunity for freedom\*\*
- God is \_\_\_\_\_, I am \_\_\_\_,
  - What we put in these blanks are either TRUE or LIES and they affect everything
  - Truth will always create freedom, When we believe lies it creates a dissonance in our hearts which can lead to arguments and such
- You are God's handiwork created to something that he prepared just for you to do
  - He delights in you (like Doug delights in his grand children)
  - Beyond your wildest imagination
  - No sin could make Him love us less. No good work can make us love Him more
  - Zephaniah 3:17
  - "God loves you, God is on your side, He's coming after you, He's relentless
- What does this have to do with missions??
  - Everything
  - We are purveyors of Justice
  - We are called to bring the message we have received to this in Bondage
