

Saturday & Sunday, November 11 & 12, 2017 - "Walk in Wisdom" - Gerald Coleman

Key Passages: Colossians 4:2-6

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- · Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- Paul wanted the church to grow up into full maturity and live out there calling to be the image/likeness of God
- Continue in prayer (steadfast, living life with God)
 - Not about saying prayers all the time but about continual communion with God
 - Thinking constantly about the Lord
 - There is freedom and creativity in how we follow God
- · "Pray for us"
 - God will open a door for the Good News
 - We need to be praying for the spreading of the Gospel (to impact/transform)
 - · We also need to be praying for clarity and wisdom
- How to do we talk to those around us about Jesus?
 - Walk in wisdom (v5)
 - We become the Bible and a representation of Jesus to this who haven't been to church and don't know the Bible
 - There are many who don't know Jesus
 - · Making the best use of time
 - Kairos = window of opportunity
 - Turn minutes into moments
 - Ask the Spirit to make us aware
 - We talk about evangelism as if it's all about us
 - · God is already speaking and moving and calling
 - As if God is asking "Will you tune-in to what I'm up to?"
 - It's about BEING AVAILABLE
 - Speech always gracious and seasoned with salt
 - It's GOOD NEWS (it should sound and feel like good news)
 - Not salt in a wound BUT flavor
- · Turning minutes into moments
 - STOP Pause and ask what God is doing
 - LOOK Pay attention. Seeing and engaging with PEOPLE
 - LISTEN Listen to them and to the Holy Spirit
 - **There is creativity in how we share**
- Our job is just to share
 - It is not our job to take someone from -10 to +10 (but maybe just from -10 to -7)
 - We are called to step out of our selfish comfort zone...we have nothing to lose
 - We are not working ALONE. God will show us the way

- 1. Have you ever prayed for God to open a door for the Good News? How did it go? How did God respond?
- 2. How is God calling you to step up your prayer for the spreading of the Gospe?
- 3. When was a time when you had a good experience sharing Jesus with someone?
- 4. What has God taught you about sharing the Gospel? What to say, how to pray, how to be ready?
- 5. Which part of the STOP, LOOK, LISTEN do you need to grow in the most?
- 6. When was a time when God blessed and lead you when you stepped out of your comfort zone to share Jesus?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or message?
